Art.1p. EVENT ORGANISATION

On the 7th, 8th and 9th of July 2023, ASA ALSACE, with SALM AUTO SPORT, the city of LA BROQUE and under patronage of the *Comité de pilotage*, organises an automobile event **PEA** (foreign participation authorized) named:

Drivers' briefing: A written briefing will be handed out during the administrative checks. If necessary, an oral briefing will take place on Saturday July 8th 2023 at the Officers' Park.

Display of competitors authorized to participate in practice: Saturday July 8th 2023 at 10:00 AM.

Timed trial sessions (two climbs): Saturday July 8th 2023 starting at 10:30 AM.

Untimed trial sessions: Sunday July 9th 2023 from 8:15 AM to 9:15 AM

RACE:
1st Climb : Saturday July 8th 2023 after the timed trial sessions
2nd Climb : Sunday July 9th 2023 after the untimed trial sessions
3rd Climb : Sunday July 9th 2023 after the second Climb

This timetable is given as an indication and is subject to change by Race Control. Competitors will be informed via a notice board.

Posting of the provisional official results:

Sunday July 9th 2023, after the last driver has arrived in Parc Fermé.

Prize-giving for all competitors:

Panel of Stewards' 1st meeting:

Friday July 7th 2023 at 6:00 PM at the structure near the start line.

The next meetings will be scheduled by the panel's President

Official notice boards: During the whole event: at the different "*Competitors' Parks*".

Parc Fermé:

Mandatory

After the last climb, all classified cars are considered to be in Parc Fermé (on pain of immediate disqualification) for 30 minutes on their spot at the Service Park. During that time, these cars need to be on plastic sheets and not loaded on trailers or trucks.

Art.1.2p. Checks

Scrutineering:

Friday July 7th 2023 -2:15 PM to 7:00 PM & Saturday July 8th 2023 - 8:30 AM to 9:30 AM Car Park in front of *la salle polyvalente* (See conditions in art1.4p)

Competitors' Parks:

At Ets OBERLIN

Competitors will submit their driving licence and their licence, and must also submit their car's homologation form. Foreign competitors must also submit the written authorization of their ASN if it was not attached in their registration form.

The express nominal authorization of the owner of the car that will participate to the event needs to be submitted for any driver that will drive a leased/loaned car.

No verification will be done after the closing time of control: Saturday July 8th 2023 9:15 AM.

After scrutineering, the list of authorized drivers to participate in the practice sessions will be displayed after being endorsed by the panel of stewards during its meeting and signed and displayed by the clerk of the course.

Checks that require the dismantling of a car will be done at the *Garage SEAT* in ROTHAU. Maximum manpower hourly rate : 60€ including taxes

Art.1.3p Weighing

Cars Weight control will take place at the "*Modern Competitors' Park*".

Art.1.4p. Supplementary provisions

Administrative checks and scrutineering (relative to Art. 1.4p):

Saturday's checks are reserved to competitors that are not available on Friday and that have obtained a written agreement from the organiser.

Times for these checks will be notified on ASA ALSACE's website.

Art.4p. CARS AND EQUIPMENTS

Art.4.1p. Eligible Cars

The maximum eligible cars is 50

All eligible cars must be in accordance to FIA regulations (performance factor).

Category 1 – Performance Factor

Group 1: PF 15 to 39

Group 2: PF 40 to 79

Group 3: PF 80 to 119

Group 4: PF 120 to 159

Group 5: above PF 159

NB: 2023 Season

Before any entry with the organiser of an FIA Hill Clim competition, competitors must:

- Have registered the car entered on the PF website: www.fiaperformancefactor.com
- Have completed the PF technical sheet
- Have obtained both PF and PF-ID logins associated to the car entered.

Art.5p. ADVERTISING

Art.6p. SITES AND INFRASTRUCTURES

Art.6.1p. Course

The event will take place on the CD 126 on the following course:

- Start: On the CD 126, 50 m after the "LA BROQUE" exit.
- Finish: On the CD 126, 800 m after FRECONRUPT
- Course Length: 2 446 m
- Drop: 370 m
- Average slope: 8,7%

The event will consist of **3 mandatory climbs**. **ONLY the best climb will count for the classification.**

Starting procedure: each car will start in the order stated by article 7 of the standard regulations.

Art.6.2p. Race Course

On CD 126.

Art.6.3p. Starting queue

On CD 126 in LA BROQUE

Reminder : Drivers must join the starting queue in the zone affected to this effect before the start at the latest **10 minutes** before their starting time. The driver's competitor that has not presented the car before that deadline can be refused the right to start the round.

Art.6.4p. Signalling

Art.6.5p. Competitors' Parks

VERY IMPORTANT:

The Competitors' Park is located in LA BROQUE at the Ets OBERLIN and will be accessible **as of 2:00 PM on Friday July 7th 2023**. Before settling there, competitors must announce themselves to the responsible DC delegate at the Frédéric DUMAS's Park.

Parking of competition cars and service vehicles is strictly forbidden outside of the parks, especially on public roads and/or in public spaces, without the express authorization of the organiser. Any infraction will be sanctioned by a 150 € fine and by the exclusion of the competitors if they do not comply and/or reoffend.

Trailers must be parked by order of the park manager.

Pre-grid preparation will take place on Général DE GAULLE's street.

In every Competitors' Park, competitors are asked to :

- Keep a fire extinguishers within immediate reach of every car : the fire extinguisher must be appropriate for class A, B and C fires, it must have a minimum capacity of 5 kg and must have been checked within the last two years.
- Place a waterproof sheet under each competition car : the waterproof plastic sheet must be resistant to hydrocarbons and have dimensions at least equal to the car (minimum dimensions 3 x 5m).
- Dispose of their waste at the latest when leaving the service park.

The penalty for the lack of a fire extinguisher and/or a plastic sheet in the parks is set to 200 € and/or 400 €.

Art.6.6p. Final Parc Fermé

The Final Parc Fermé is mandatory.

After the last climb, all classified cars are considered to be in Parc Fermé (on pain of immediate disqualification) for 30 minutes on their spot at the Service Park. During that time, these cars need to be on plastic sheets and not loaded on trailers or trucks.

Art.6.7p. Official notice boards

There will be notice boards in place during checks, practices and the race in the Competitors' Parks.

Art.6.8p. Permanence

During the event, a permanent presence will be on the start line on July 8th and 9th 2023 from 7:30 AM to 7:00 PM.

Art.7p. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

Art.7.1p. Driver's briefing

The written briefing issued against signature during the administrative checks acts as an oral briefing.

If necessary, an oral briefing will take place on Saturday the 8th of July at 9:00 AM in the Competitors' Park. If every driver's presence is required, it is mandatory that they sign the attendance sheet.

Art.7.2p. Race

Starting procedure: tricolor lights.

TROPHEE DES NATIONS' Competitors will take the start between the VHC Competitors and the "Championnat de France de la Montagne's" Competitors.

1st Climb: Saturday July 8th 2023 after the timed trial sessions

2nd Climb: Sunday July 9th 2023 after the untimed trial sessions

3rd Climb: Sunday July 9th 2023 after the second Climb

This timetable is given as an indication and is subject to change by Race Control. Competitors will be informed by notice board.

AFTER EVERY CLIMB, DRIVERS MUST RETURN THEIR COMPETITOR'S PARK ON PAIN OF SANCTIONS.

Art.7.3p. Pre-heating tyres

It is forbidden for drivers to heat their tyres mechanically before the start, by moving their vehicle or by any other means **WITHIN THE AREA BETWEEN COMPETITORS' PARKS EXITS AND THE START LINE.**

The use of tyre blankets or any other similar device is only allowed in official Competitors' Parks and is prohibited between these parks and the start line.

Art.8p. PENALTIES

See "*réglementation standard des Courses de Côtes*".

Art.9p. CLASSIFICATIONS

Art.9.1p.

- The event will consist of three mandatory climbs.
- Classification will taken from **over the best race climb**.
- If a competitor is unable to do one of the three climbs, he must have to have it established by a scrutineer and have it accepted by a decision from stewards.

Art.9.2p. The following classifications will be drawn up:

- 1 production cars general classification (Cat. 1)
- 1 competition cars general classification (Cat. 2)
- 1 class classification

Art.10p. PRIZES

Prizes will be distributed in the following manner:

Art.10.2p. Cups

A cup will be awarded to each classified competitor.

Art.10.4p. Prize-Giving and Cup-Giving

The prize-giving ceremony will be conducted in public in the form of a podium on Sunday July 9th 2023 in the Modern Competitors' Park (in front of *la salle polyvalente de la Broque*).

10.5p. Cheque-giving and list of winners
